Showgoers will also enjoy a selection of stalls featuring motoring gear as well as food vendors.

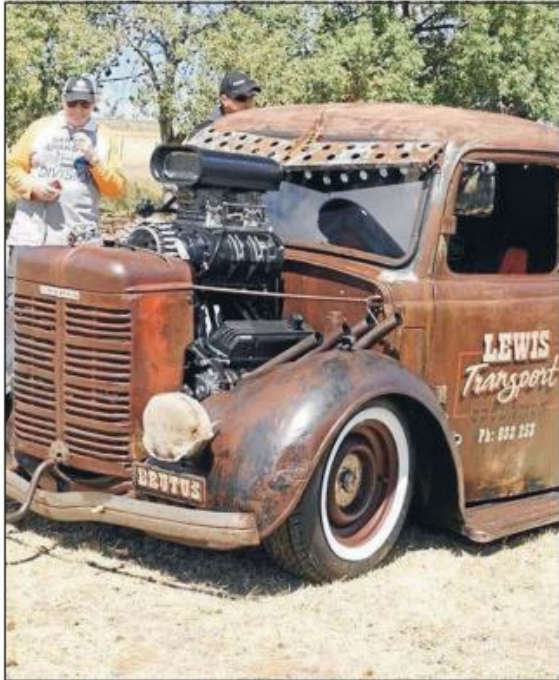
All proceeds on the day will go to the Junee Hospital Auxiliary. To date the Junee Motor Club has donated almost \$10,000 back into the community.
